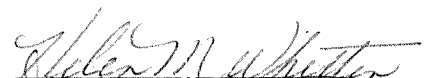
PW Committee Discussion held regarding the June 21st, 2011 Public Works Committee meeting pertaining to 49A Street paving repairs.
