

TOWN OF SEDGEWICK—THE SCOOP - August 2017

July 6, 2017 Special Council Meeting Highlights

- Council endorsed the appointment of Mr. Jim Fedyk as the Chief Administrative Officer for the Town of Sedgewick effective July 17, 2017.
- Council endorsed Development Permit 2017-05 for a variance on the height of a maintenance shop expansion and office building from 10.0 to 10.9 metres on Plan 4239TR, Block 24.

July 27, 2017 Regular Council Meeting Highlights

- Council endorsed a motion to endorse the recommendation from the Regional Emergency Services Committee to extend the existing Regional Fire Agreement by one year, to expire on December 31, 2018.
- Council endorsed a motion directing Administration to organize the installation of the old Town entrance sign at the Museum's 'Goose Creek School' site, in coordination with the Sedgewick Archives & Museum Board.
- Council endorsed a motion to endorse the Sedgewick Lake Park Association recommendation to appoint Jodie Djos and Theresa Schmutz to the Park's Board.
- Council endorsed a motion directing the CAO to research services for the Commercial Building Inspection of the Sedgewick Recreational Centre.
