### September 21, 2017 Council Meeting Highlights

### Electric Franchise Fee - No Increase

Council passed a resolution to maintain the Fortis Alberta Electric Franchise Fee at 8% for 2018.

### Flagstaff Waste Management—Memorandum of Agreement (MOU)

Council approved an MOU with Flagstaff Waste Management to decommission the Sedgewick Transfer Site.

### Solid Waste Bylaw

Council gave final readings to Solid Waste Bylaw #533/17.

The Bylaw speaks to the following issues:

- $\Rightarrow$  Requirement for all garbage to be placed within a hardcover receptacle.
- $\Rightarrow$  Proper placement and location of receptacles put out for collection.
- ⇒ Times and duration that the receptacles can be placed out for pickup
- ⇒ Upkeep/vandalism of receptacles
- ⇒ Disturbance of residential waste that has been put out for collection
- $\Rightarrow$  Items that cannot be placed out for collection
- $\Rightarrow$  Provisions of yard waste collection
- ⇒ Enforcement of the Bylaw

The Bylaw states that the CAO or Bylaw Officer, at their discretion, may issue a letter or notice to any one in contravention of the Bylaw with timeframe to complete any action required. Non-compliance would result in a fine of \$100 for the first offence and \$200 for subsequent offences.

### **RFC Phase II Funding**

Council approved recommendations of the Recreation Funding Committee to allocate Phase II grant funding as follows:


