October 19, 2017 Council Organizational Meeting Highlights

Oaths for Office - Council swore Oaths for Office before a Commissioner of Oaths.

Appointment of Deputy Mayor - Council approved an alphabetical 12-month rotational schedule for the Deputy Mayor appointment:

October 2017 to September 2018	Councillor Imlah
October 2018 to September 2019	Councillor Levy
October 2019 to September 2020	Councillor Schmutz
October 2020 to September 2021	Councillor Sparrow

Code of Conduct—The Mayor and Councillors signed a Code of Conduct for the 2018-2022 Term of Office.

Council Remuneration -Council endorsed a motion to approve a \$100/month increase to Councillor's monthly remuneration and a \$225/month increase to the Mayor's monthly remuneration and that all Council and external scheduled meetings be paid at half-day or full-day rates other than ad-hoc meetings which will be paid at an hourly rate retroactive to October 1st, 2017.

October 19, 2017 Council Regular Meeting Highlights

Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Association - Sedgewick Council *approved* the 2018 Regional Solid Waste Management Association Budget as presented with Sedgewick's requisition at \$123,685.04. The budget resulted in a 2.2% budget reduction from 2017 equivalent to \$2,904.55. A majority of the Flagstaff municipalities must approve this budget prior to formal endorsement being attained.

Parkland Regional Library Board - Sedgewick Council *approved* the 2018 Parkland Regional Library budget as presented. Sedgewick's 2018 requisition will increase by \$68.56 from \$6,890.28 in 2017 to \$6,958.64 which is equivalent to less than a 1% increase.

Emergency Services Committee - Sedgewick Council *endorsed* a recommendation from the Regional Emergency Services Committee to extend the Regional Fire Chief Agreement by one year from December 31, 2017 to December 31, 2018.

E-Billing

The Town of Sedgewick provides the option of e-billing for Utility Invoices. Ratepayers not interested in e-billing still have the option to receive their utility invoice by mail.


