



## April 26, 2018 Council Special Meeting Highlights

A special meeting of the Town of Sedgewick Council was held on Thursday, April 26 at 6:00 PM under the authority of section 194 of the Municipal Government Act to address the following business:

#### Karizma Entertainment Proposal

Council approved submitting an offer for a performance by "Trooper" on July 15, 2018; subsequently the offer has been accepted. (See below)

Council approved the purchase of a 28'x32' stage with accessories .

#### 2018 Revised Capital Budget

Council approved the 2018 revised Capital Budget at a total amount of \$5,029,600 with \$1,639,600 to be allocated from reserves, \$2,390,000 from grants and \$1,000,000 from debenture.

#### 2018 Revised Operating Budget

Council approved the revised 2018 Operational Budget of \$2,106,287 and \$289,355 of amortization.

#### **Recreation Funding – Phase I**

Council approved the recommendations of the Recreation Funding Committee and allocated a total of \$120,695 in Phase I of 2018.


