



# TOWN OF SEDGEWICK—THE SCOOP - May 2019



## April 2, 2019 Council Special Meeting Highlights

Council approved that the Town of Sedgewick offer a 50% tax incentive for 10 years in relation to the property described as Plan 3835P, Block 10, Lots 8-10 so as to induce the sale of the property to a commercial interest to be used to house their long term operations.

## April 18, 2019 Council Regular Meeting Highlights

### **Procedural Bylaw 555**

The recent Municipal Accountability Program Review identified gaps in Bylaw 535, which is the Town of Sedgewick Procedural Bylaw. Council rescinded Bylaw 535 and passed Procedural Bylaw 555 which addressed the gaps:

- ◆ Removed provisions that allowed for councillors to cancel meetings in writing
- ◆ Removed the allowance for all votes that were not unanimous to be recorded votes
- ◆ Corrected the term “in Camera” to a “closed session”

### **Animal Control Bylaw 556**

Dog Control Bylaw 464 was approved in August 2009. Animal Control Bylaw 556 rescinded Bylaw 464 and was passed with updates that included:

- ◆ New definitions for Nuisance, Service and Restricted Dogs
- ◆ New Licensing categories for Nuisance, Service & Restricted Dogs
- ◆ New requirements of an owner whose animal/dog has been classified as a nuisance or restricted animal
- ◆ New restrictions the CAO may impose for Nuisance and Restricted Dogs

### **Recreation & Culture Boards Sub-Committee Appointments**

Council appointed Councillors Sparrow and Schmutz to the new Recreation and Culture Boards Sub-Committee established this spring, comprised of two councillors and two designates from each of the Recreation, Golf Club, Community Hall and the Sedgewick Lake Park Boards, charged with three main goals:

- ◆ To develop a cohesive staffing structure through shared employment between the recreation and culture boards.
- ◆ To explore other areas of partnership that may be beneficial to the recreation and culture boards.
- ◆ To forward recommendations to the respective recreation and culture boards for approval.

The Combined Assessment/Tax notices will be mailed on May 30<sup>th</sup> with an Assessment Date as of June 7<sup>th</sup>

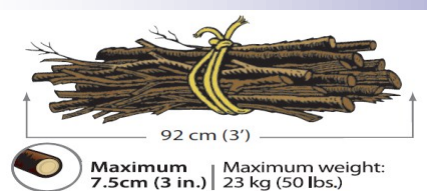
The deadline for Assessment Appeals is August 6, 2019.

### **Residential Yard Waste Pickup**

Between the months of April and October, yard waste, except for leaves and grass clippings, will be picked up on Thursdays. Yard waste must be placed in a paper bag. Bundles must be *less than 3 feet in length* and *weigh less than 50 pounds* and branches must be *less than 3 inches in diameter*.

It is the resident's responsibility to deposit leaves and grass in a Sedgewick bin at the Recycling Centre at 4819—48 Avenue (behind The Wooden Spoon.)

For large tree clean-up or yard waste that exceed these dimensions, the Town may provide a Town truck parked at a location agreeable to the resident for waste to be deposited in for a duration of time; go to the Town website to top right side of the page to "I want to...Book...Town Truck for Yard Clean Up
