May 8, 2019 Council Special Meeting Highlights

Council awarded the Main Street and Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project to Border Paving Ltd. at the bid price of \$2,755,403.25 contingent upon reference and issuance of a Notice of Acceptance letter to the successful bidder.

Council rescheduled the May regular meeting to Wednesday, May 22nd, 2019 at 6:00 pm to be held in the Town of Sedgewick Administration Office.

May 22, 2019 Council Regular Meeting Highlights

2019 Operating Budget

Council approved the 2019 Operating Budget set out with a request for \$830,000 in Taxes which is a 1.76% increase overall, including the Alberta School Foundation Fund and the Senior Foundation Housing requisitions.

2019 Capital Budget

Council approved the 2019 Capital Budget with capital spending totalling \$3,879,000.
