# Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019

**Bylaw 562 – LUB 461 Amendment**

Council approved final reading to Bylaw 562 that amends Land Use Bylaw 461 regarding fencing.

**Bylaw 563 – Designated Officers**

Council approved Designated Officers Bylaw 563 that establishes the positions of certain Designated Officers and establishes a framework for delegation of Administration functions.

**Bylaw 564 – Traffic Control Bylaw**

Council approved first reading to Traffic Bylaw 564 that establishes the municipal authority respecting transport and transportation systems within the municipality. **NOTE:** All Bylaws are viewable on [sedgewick.ca](http://sedgewick.ca)

**Nutec ElectroTel – High Speed Internet**

Council approved an agreement with Nutec Electro Tel to provide high speed internet within the Town of Sedgewick and the immediate perimeter.

**SustainErgy Group – Wild Rose Coop Rec Centre Scoping Audit**

Council directed Administration to proceed with an engineering study with SustainErgy Group as the next step in the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre ([MCCAC](#)) Rebate Program for the Wild Rose Coop Recreation Centre.
