# Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019

## Bylaw 564 – Traffic Control Bylaw

Council endorsed final reading to Traffic Bylaw 564; available on [sedgewick.ca](http://sedgewick.ca)

## Fortis Alberta - 2020 Electric Franchise Fee

Council approved an increase of the FortisAB Electric Franchise Fee from 8 to 9% for 2020.

## Parkland Regional Library Board 2020 Budget

Council approved the Parkland Region Library 2020 budget, as presented, with a requisition of \$6,935.05 to the Town.

## Recreation Funding – Phase II

Council approved the allocation of \$4,016 to the Sedgewick Community Hall Association and \$4,174 to the Sedgewick Lake Park Association for Phase II Funding.

## FIP – Management Model

Council approved the recommendation of the FIP Committee to eliminate the FIP Committee and split responsibilities among municipalities with current operations to wind up no later than December 31, 2019.

## Municipal Collaboration – Community Peace Officer Program

Council directed Administration to budget \$6,500 in capital and \$23,200 in operating costs in 2020 for the Community Peace Officer Program to be reviewed further upon presentation of the 2020 Budget.

## 2127358 Alberta Ltd – Conditional Development Permit

Development Permit 2019-16 for Plan 9023092, Block J, Lots A&B was conditionally approved to permit a Change in Use, to add a Caretaker's residence and no requirement to separate the street from off-street parking with a 1-metre landscaped area.
