# Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of Jan. 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020

## BYLAW 568 – AMENDMENT #13 TO THE LAND USE BYLAW 461

Council gave first reading to Bylaw 568. The bylaw amends the Land Use Bylaw by rezoning the parcel described as Plan 3825P; Block 4; Lot 14 from R1 Residential General District to R3 Residential Sectional Home District. R1 district allows for various types of detached dwellings as permitted and discretionary use. R3 district allows for sectional homes less than 8 years of age as a permitted use and more than 8 years of age as a discretionary use. Other differences between the districts can be found in Land Use Bylaw 461 found on the Town’s website at sedgewick.ca. Adjacent landowners will be notified by mail of the proposed amendment and a public hearing will be advertised and held on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Second and third reading of the bylaw is required in order to be approved.

## SNOW REMOVAL POLICY 18/05

The snow removal policy was amended by combining sidewalk/trail priorities with road priorities. The policy now consists of a single list of seven categorized priorities with each priority receiving a defined service level and trigger.

## OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY 20/13

The OHS Policy sets out the Town of Sedgewick’s standards for protecting the health and safety of staff, contractors, visitors and the public. Policy 20/13 identifies as a supplement to the policy a Health and Safety Management System which includes requirements for training, job competency, meetings and preventative actions as well as management responsibilities.

## TOWN OF SEDGEWICK APP

Council approved the development of a custom Town of Sedgewick app by a freelance developer with a budget of \$4500 and to be funded from the general operating reserve.

## ‘IF IN DOUBT’ BIN

Council approved the removal of the ‘if in doubt’ bin by Flagstaff Waste due to misuse.

## FEDERATION OF CANADIAN MUNICIPALITIES 2020 CONFERENCE

Council approved the attendance of Councillor Levy at the 2020 FCM Conference to be held in Toronto, ON on the condition that Clr. Levy pays for his own flight.

## SEDEGWICK PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD MEMBER APPOINTMENT

Council approved the appointment of Stephane Lecours to the Sedgewick Public Library Board for a three-year term.
