Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of July 29th, 2020

POLICY 20/14 - ASSET MANAGEMENT POLICY

Council approved Policy 20/14, the Asset Management Policy. The policy was developed by MuniSight Ltd. as a regional project funded completely through the Alberta Community Partnership grant. The policy defines the principles of asset management and lays the framework for an asset management strategy and plan which will determine how the policy is achieved.

REGIONAL EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMITTEE - EXCESS LEGAL COSTS

Council agreed to share the costs with partner municipalities and pay \$1317.31 towards outstanding legal fees attributed to the development of legal documents for the formation of the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society.

SEDGEWICK LAKE PARK BOARD - AGREEMENT

Council appointed Clr. Schmutz and Clr. Imlah as their representatives on an adhoc committee to negotiate a lease agreement with the Sedgewick Lake Park Board.

INTERNET SERVICE - TOWER INSTALLATION

Council allocated an additional \$17,000 towards the installation of an internet tower next to the sewage lift station. This is in addition to \$15,000 that was allocated during a special meeting on June 25th.

REQUEST FOR SPONSORSHIP - PODCAST

Council agreed to sponsor an episode of a historical podcast on the Town of Sedgewick created by Canadian History Ehx at a cost of \$250.

CONTRACTED SERVICES - SNOW REMOVAL AND GRASS CUTTING

Council deferred discussion of contracting snow removal and grass cutting services to the August regular meeting of Council.

AUGUST REGULAR MEETING - RESCHEDULING

Council rescheduled the August regular to August 27th, 2020 at 6pm to be held at the Sedgewick Community Hall.
