# **Council Highlights**

# BYLAW 575 - FLAGSTAFF REGIONAL SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD AMENDING BYLAW

Council gave all three readings to Bylaw 575, which amended the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board bylaw to include the Village of Amisk. Council also approved entering into a new SDAB agreement to include the Village of Amisk.

### SEDGEWICK KILLAM NATURAL GAS SYSTEM - METER SYSTEM UPGRADE

Council approved amending the 2020 Capital Budget by increasing the amount to fund the Water Meter System Upgrade by \$50,000. The reason for the increase is to supply new Neptune meter heads to residences with outdated meters to allow the meters to work effectively with the new drive-by meter reading technology.

# BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER - APPOINTMENT

Council appointed Wayne Nyback to the designated officer position of Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Wayne is replacing Daryl Reinke who has retired from the position.

# SEDGEWICK LAKE PARK BOARD - AMENDMENT TO NEW AGREEMENT

Council approved minor amendments to the new agreement with the Sedgewick Lake Park Board. The amendments include identifying a power line that runs from the Lake Park to the cemetery and the lending of town equipment to the board.

Council approved a motion to have meetings return to Council Chambers in the Town office with Covid precautions taken. Members of the public attending meetings will be asked to wear masks.
