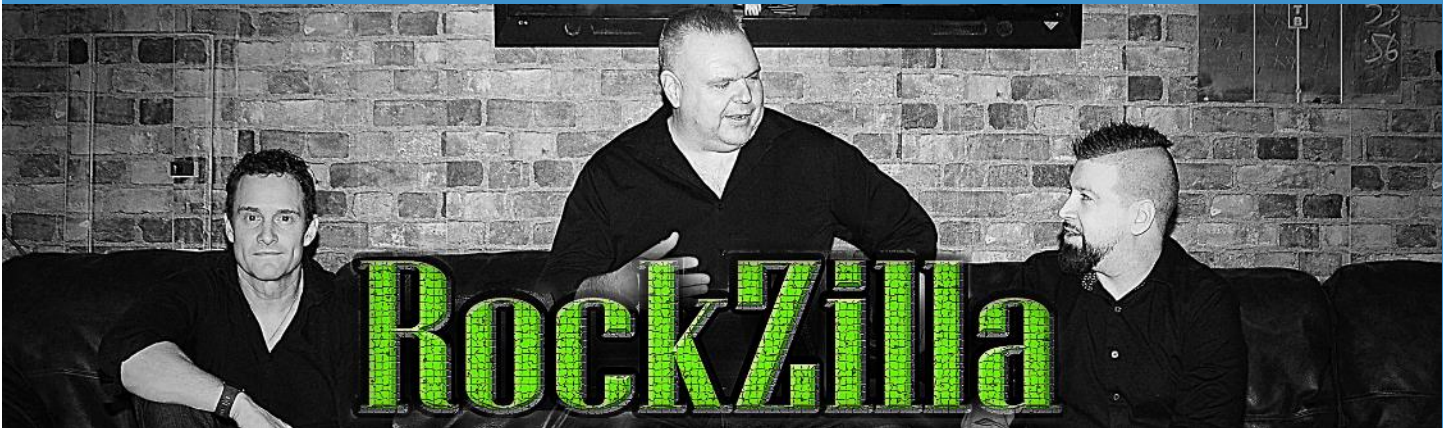




THE SEDGEWICK SCOOP

Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of August 27th, 2020

CONTRACTED SERVICES - SNOW REMOVAL AND GRASS CUTTING

Council approved entering into a 5-year agreement with the Sedgewick Recreation Board to provide snow removal and grass cutting services.

SEDGEWICK LAKE PARK BOARD - LEASE AMENDMENT

Council approved entering into the new 20-year lease with the Sedgewick Lake Park board.

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER - REPLACEMENT

Council approved entering into a contract with J.A.G. Security 2018 Inc. to provide Bylaw Enforcement Services to the Town of Sedgewick for a one-year period.

FLAGSTAFF REGIONAL EMERGENCY SERVICES SOCIETY - FLAGSTAFF COUNTY FORMATION CONDITIONS

Council reviewed a letter from Flagstaff County and directed administration to respond with the following decisions;

- 1) That the Town of Sedgewick does not agree that Flagstaff County should have veto voting rights for the FRESS annual budgets;
- 2) That the Town of Sedgewick does not agree to a \$450,000 requisition cap for Flagstaff County;
- 3) That the Town of Sedgewick does not agree that a third business plan should be developed prior to the formation of the society.

ARENA ROOF - ESTIMATES

Council approved including the arena roof replacement and ventilation project in the 2021 capital budget at an estimated amount of \$1.3m.

WILD ROSE CO-OP RECREATION CENTRE - INSURANCE CLAIM

Council directed Administration to pay \$15,488.56 to the Sedgewick Recreation Centre Board as their portion of the insurance payout for the break-in of the arena which occurred February 16th, 2020.
