Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of October 22nd, 2020

FLEET VEHICLE – SALE OF PICKUP TRUCK

Council approved the sale of the 2016 Dodge Ram pickup truck to the Sedgewick Golf Club for payments of \$15,000 in 2020, \$5000 in 2021 and \$5000 in 2022 plus GST.

BYLAW 576 - INTERMUNICIPAL ASSESSMENT REVIEW BOARDS BYLAW

Council gave all three readings to Bylaw 576 and approved entering into the corresponding agreement to include the Village of Amisk as a member of the Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board.

SEDGEWICK PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD - APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS

Council approved the appointment of Gay Backen, Velma Armitage and Lynnette Hayes to the Sedgewick Public Library Board for a 3 year term expiring on October 1st, 2023.

FLAGSTAFF INTER-MUNICIPAL PARTNERSHIP - JOINT AGREEMENT

Council approved entering into a new Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership joint agreement, returning \$6,699 to the partnership for use as seed money and appointed councillors to each FIP sub-committee.

ELECTRICAL DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM - FRANCHISE FEES 2021

Council approved maintaining the Fortis Franchise Fee at 9% in 2021.

PARKLAND REGIONAL LIBRARY SYSTEM - 2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

Council approved the 2021 PRL budget with the requisition to the Town of Sedgewick remaining unchanged at \$6,934.

FLAGSTAFF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES - 2021 BUDGET

Council approved the 2021 FCSS budget accepting a requisition of \$7055.70 for the Town of Sedgewick.
