Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of November 19th, 2020

BYLAW 577 - FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW

Council gave all three readings to Bylaw 577, the Town of Sedgewick Fees and Charges Bylaw. The annual bylaw has increased water, sewer, and garbage utility charges by 2%.

CAPITAL BUDGET - 2021

Council approved the 2021 Capital Budget and Forecast as presented for a total of \$1,370,000. The budget includes the purchase of a street sweeper, flat deck truck and the repair of the arena roof.

RANGE ROAD 124 - MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH FLAGSTAFF COUNTY

Council entered into a cost share agreement with Flagstaff County for the maintenance of Range Road 124 between Town corporate limits and Sedgewick Lake Park.

SEDGEWICK PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD - REQUEST FOR RELIEF OF RENT

Council decided to provide \$2500 in Covid relief to organizations managing Town assets. The organizations include Sedgewick Public Library, Sedgewick Community Hall, Sedgewick Rec Board, Sedgewick Golf Club and Sedgewick Lake Park.

REGIONAL EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMITTEE - RECOMMENDATIONS

Council approved the recommendations to apply a budgetary cap to Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services budgets, to extend the current fire agreements with Flagstaff County for 6 months and to begin the process of hiring a Regional Fire Chief.

FIBER DESIGN - CONNECT MOBILITY

Council approved a budget of \$12,000 to design an internet fiber network in town which would identify routes for buried fiber from a point of access to 8 aerial structures including the two existing towers.
