TOWN OF SEDGEWICK BYLAW NO. 573 TOWN OF SEDGEWICK AMENDMENT #1 TO THE TAX PAYMENT & PENALTY BYLAW

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF SEDGEWICK, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING BYLAW 568

WHEREAS the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 Sections 344, 345 and 346 regarding tax penalties and amendments thereto, the Council of the Town of Sedgewick has adopted Bylaw 568, the Tax Payment and Penalty Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 568 due to the impact of COVID-19;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Sedgewick in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Citation

This Bylaw may be cited as "Amendment #1 to the Tax Payment & Penalty Bylaw".

2. Provisions

Section 5 is hereby amended as follows:

5. b. For the 2020 taxation year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all property taxes levied on non-residential properties shall not have a tax penalty imposed until November 1st, 2020.

3. Severability

3.1. If any term of this Bylaw is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court or tribunal having the jurisdiction to do so, that term is to be considered to have been severed from the rest of this bylaw, and the rest of the bylaw remains in force unaffected by that finding or by the severance of that term.

4. Enactment

4.1. This Bylaw shall take effect at the date of final passing thereof.
