# TOWN OF SEDGEWICK BYLAW NO. 574/20 TOWN OF SEDGEWICK 2020 TAX BYLAW

# A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE VARIOUS RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF SEDGEWICK FOR THE 2020 TAXATION YEAR.

**WHEREAS** the Town of Sedgewick has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues, expenses and expenditures as required at the Council meeting held on May 21st, 2020; and

**WHEREAS** the estimated municipal expenses, transfers and principal debt repayments (excluding non-cash items) set out in the operating budget for the Town of Sedgewick for 2020 total \$2,163,145; and

**WHEREAS** the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$1,642,351 and the balance of \$820,651 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS the 2020 requisitions are:

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Sedgewick is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the requisitions;

AND WHEREAS the Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 357 of the Municipal Government Act provides that the Tax Bylaw may specify a minimum amount payable as property tax and the Town of Sedgewick has resolved to establish a minimum tax;

**AND WHEREAS** the assessed value of all property in the Town of Sedgewick as shown on the assessment roll is:

**AND NOW THEREFORE** under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Sedgewick in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

### 1. Taxation Rates

That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property shown on the assessment roll of the Town of Sedgewick:

#### 2. Minimum Tax
