Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of February 18th, 2021

RECREATION BOARD - GRASS CUTTING

Council approved an annual grant to be paid to the Recreation Board for \$40,000 and have delegated the Town’s grass cutting responsibilities to the Recreation Centre manager. Council approved the purchase of an 80” brushcat mower for the amount of \$11,330 and the sale of a Kubota riding mower. Council directed that the rec centre will provide any extra manpower required by public works staff at a cost of \$30/hr. The Town will no longer hire summer or seasonal staff.

BYLAW 579/21 - MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION BYLAW

Council gave all three readings to the Municipal Planning Commission Bylaw which establishes the members and protocols of the Commission. The MPC makes decisions on development permit applications that involve discretionary uses.

DUFFERIN AVENUE - TRAFFIC COMPLAINT

Council directed Administration to install speed limit signage at both entrances to Dufferin Avenue along with 4 portable speed bumps evenly spaced and beginning approximately 60 feet inside each entrance. Dufferin Avenue is the back alley that runs south of the golf course.

GIBSON ENERGY - DONATION

Council approved granting the Flagstaff Scottish Club with \$951.58 which is the same amount received by Gibson Energy by donation.

IARB AND FRSDAB - MEMBER AND CHAIR APPOINTMENTS

Council appointed Deb Moffatt and Amy Jackson to the Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board and Deb Moffatt to the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board for 3-year terms. Murray Hampshire was appointed as chair for both boards.

SEDEGEWICK KILLAM NATURAL GAS SYSTEM - AGREEMENT WITH IRON CREEK GAS CO-OP

Council approved Sedgewick-Killam Natural Gas System entering into a contract with Iron Creek Gas Co-op for the operation, maintenance and emergency support of the gas system for the amount of \$10,833.34 per month.

ON LINE LOCATORS - MOWING AND SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACT

Council reviewed a proposal from On Line Locators Inc. to supply grass cutting and snow removal services, but declined the proposal.
