Council Highlights

For the regular meeting of April 15th, 2021

2020 AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Brian King, appointed auditor for the Town of Sedgewick, presented Council with the 2020 financial statements for the period ending December 31st, 2021. Council approved the statements.

CAPITAL BUDGET - 2021 AMENDED

Council approved the amended 2021 capital budget, as presented, with all projects totaling \$1,420,500. Projects include the arena roof repair and the purchase of a street sweeper, flatbed truck, fleet pickup truck (carryover from 2020) and a mower attachment for a bobcat utility vehicle.

OPERATING BUDGET - 2021 FINAL

Council deferred approving the final version of the 2021 operating budget until a special meeting held on April 22nd. **WAINWRIGHT ASSESSMENT GROUP - ASSESSMENT SERVICES CONTRACT**

Council authorized Administration to enter into a 3-year agreement for property assessment services with Wainwright Assessment Group for the fee of \$13,740 in 2021/22, \$14,016 in 2022/23 and \$14,292 in 2023/24.

RECREATION FUNDING COMMITTEE - RESIGNATION OF MEMBER

Council accepted Barb McConnell's letter of resignation from the Recreation Funding Committee and appointed Richard Debock to the Committee as a replacement.

SENIOR'S WEEK

In consideration of the past, present and future contributions of the seniors of this community and throughout Alberta, Council declared June 7 to 13, 2021 to be Seniors' Week in the Town of Sedgewick.

NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

Council declared May 16th to 22nd, 2021 as National Public Works Week and thereby urge all citizens to pay tribute and recognize the special contributions that all public works staff make in protecting our health, safety and quality of life.

For the special meeting of April 22nd, 2021 AWARDING OF TENDER

ARENA ROOF REPAIR PROJECT - AWARDING OF TENDER Council approved awarding the arena roof replacement project to Premier Fire and Flood Restoration at a bid price

of \$881,149.32. The Town is currently accepting bids for the HVAC upgrade tender portion which closes May 13th.

OPERATING BUDGET - 2021 FINAL

Council approved the final version of the 2021 operating budget as presented, but with three deletions; 1) Christmas party expense of \$5000, Public Relations expense of \$1000, Council Goodwill expense of \$2000. Amount required from propety taxes in 2021 is \$867,200.

POLICY 21/15 - SEASONAL OUTDOOR PATIO POLICY

Council approved Policy 21-15, the Seasonal Outdoor Patio Policy, as presented. The policy allows for commerical businesses to make use of sidewalk and in some cases parking stalls adjacent to their property to host patrons and furniture upon meeting the criteria of the policy and having their application approved.
