### **POLICY 21/16 - COUNCIL ORIENTATION POLICY**

Council approved the Orientation Policy which describes minimum standards of in-house training provided to newly elected councils in general elections and individual councillors in by-elections.

### **RECREATION FUNDING COMMITTEE - 2021 ALLOCATIONS**

### **RECREATION FUNDING COMMITTEE - APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATE**

Council appointed Stephen Levy as an alternate member of the Recreation Funding Committee representing Arts and Culture.

### **SEDGEWICK KILLAM NATURAL GAS SYSTEM - 2020 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

Council accepted the SKNGS recommendation to approve the 2020 Sedgewick Killam Natural Gas System Financial Statements and transfer \$32,370 to reserves.

### **WILD ROSE CO-OP RECREATION CENTRE - ENERGY CONSERVATION PROJECT**

That Council approve proceeding with the energy conservation implementation project with funding for \$15,000 to come from the Recreation Operating Reserve #49700997, which is the difference between the full cost of the project and the rebate pre-approved by the MCCAC.

### **RECREATION BOARD - APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS**

Council approved the appointment of Andrew Hampshire, Connie McArthur, Kari Sanders and Pam Kotylak to the Sedgewick Recreation Board for two-year terms.

### **REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS – JULY AND AUGUST 2021**

Council cancelled the regular meeting scheduled for July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and reschedule the August regular meeting to Thursday, August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 6pm.

### **FIRE SERVICES AGREEMENTS WITH FLAGSTAFF COUNTY**

Council approved the extension of the Fire Services Agreement and the Regional Fire Chief Services Agreement with Flagstaff County until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021, but stipulated that the agreements be terminated immediately and without the requirement of written notice at the time that the Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society absorbs the associated contracted services.

### **LIFESAVING SOCIETY ALBERTA - NATIONAL DROWNING WEEK**

Council declared July 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as National Drowning Week to focus on the drowning problem and the hundreds of lives that could be saved this year and do commend its thoughtful recognition to all citizens of our municipality.
