No meeting in July

The July regular council meeting was cancelled. August's regular meeting has been rescheduled to the 5<sup>th</sup> with the September meeting remaining on the 16<sup>th</sup> at 6pm in council chambers.

### ARENA ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT UNDERWAY

After some delay in the delivery of materials the arena roof replacement project is now in full swing. The bulk of the work is expected to take only a few weeks with the arena being ready in time to host the Streetheart concert on September 18<sup>th</sup>. The work also includes upgrading the HVAC system including the installation of four natural gas heating units. The project is being funded through a number of sources including a +\$500k CFEP grant from the Province of Alberta, MSI capital funding (provincial), Gas Tax Grant Funding (federal), recreation grant funding (originating from Flagstaff County), the Town of Sedgewick reserves and donations. Once completed the arena will be better than ever and more comfortable for attendees.





The third annual Highland Festival is being held on Saturday, August 21st, 2021. It's a day full of highland festivities, such as highland dancing, a petting zoo, artisan and food vendors, and a pig-roast supper and featuring Cabot's Crossing.
